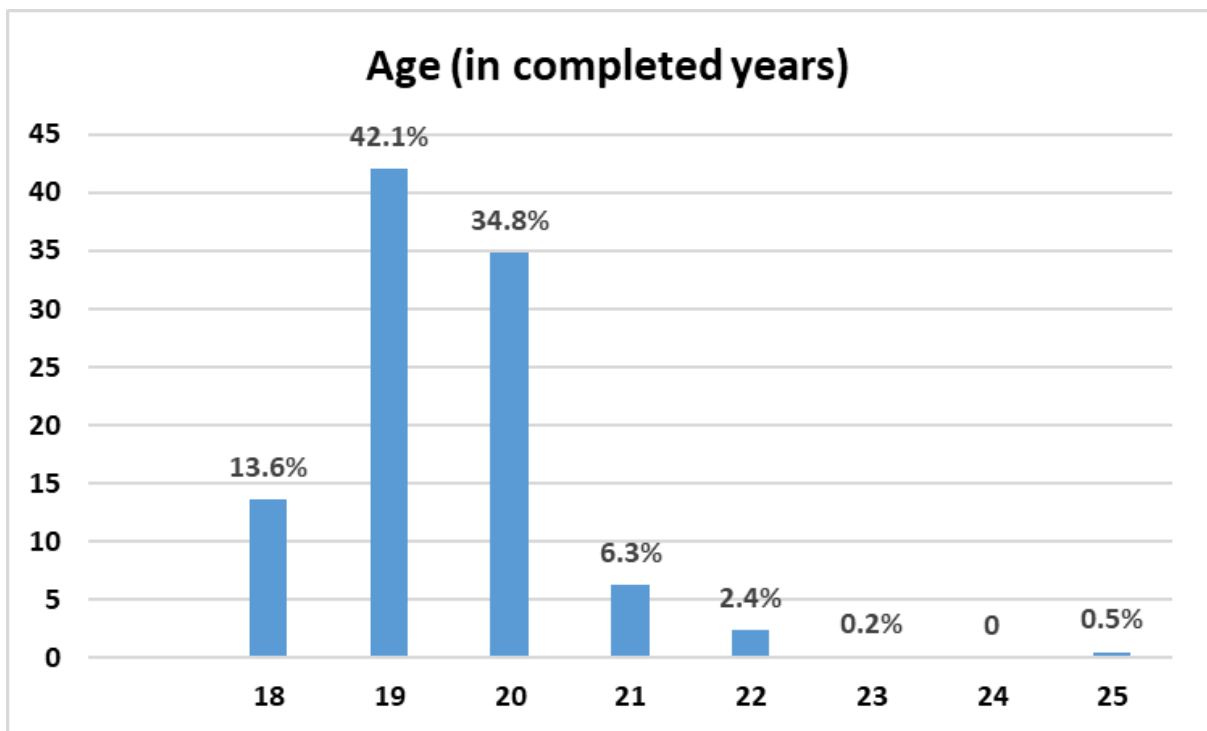
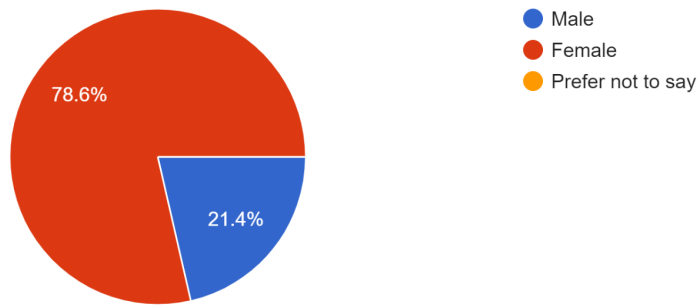
Students' Satisfaction Survey, Session 2021-2022

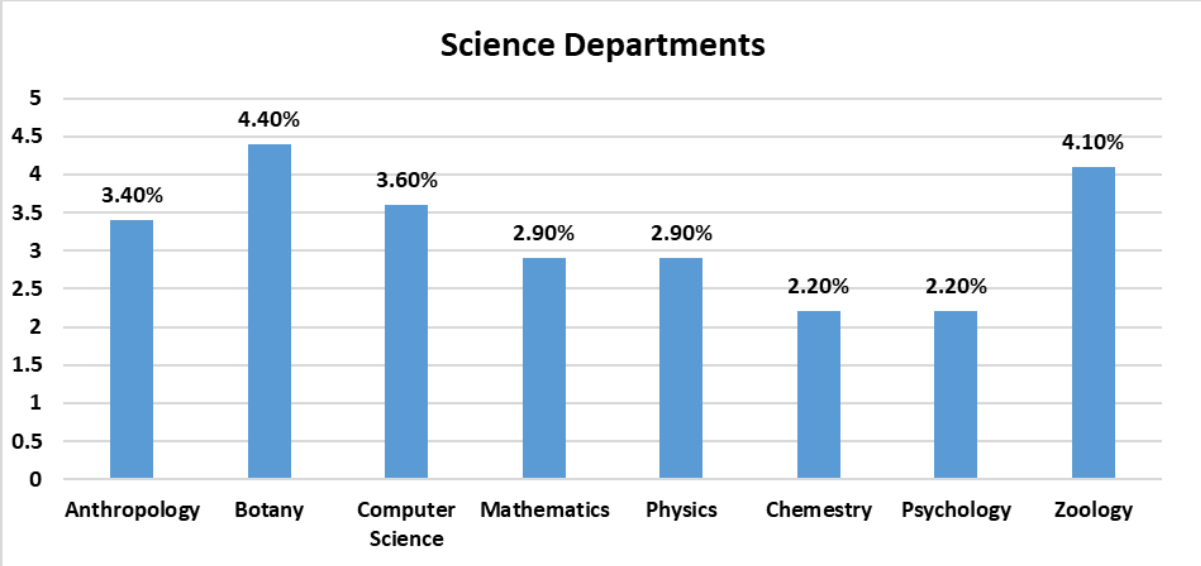
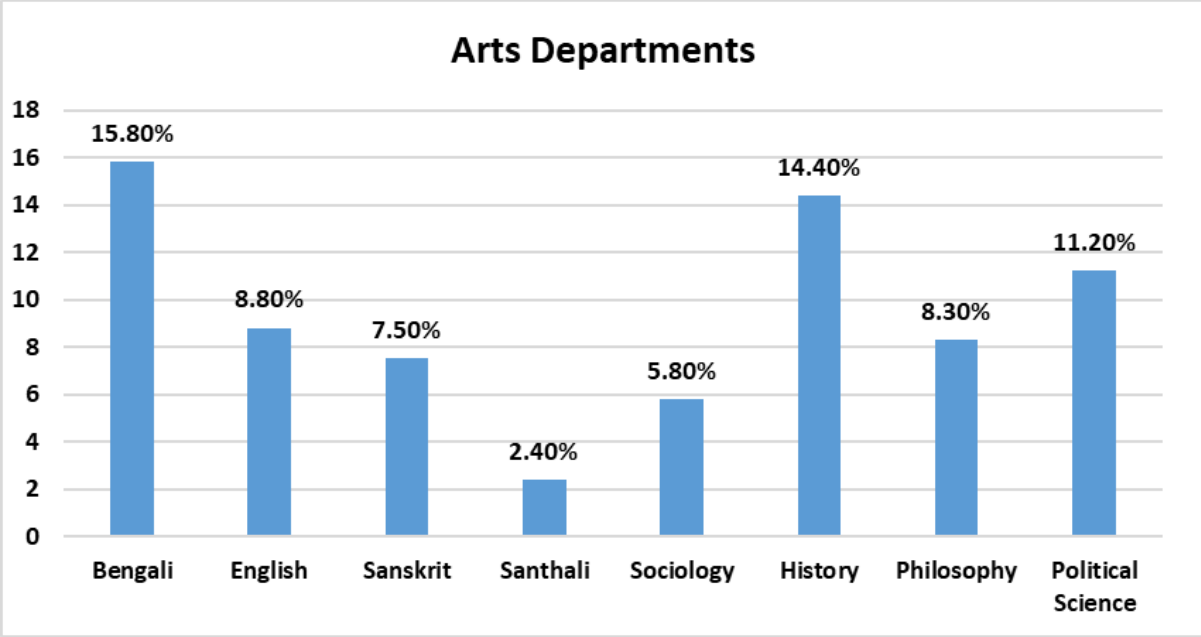
A Report

Students' Satisfaction Survey was done for the Academic Session 2021-2022, in which 411 students participated. About 90% students expressed satisfaction regarding syllabus completion and communication skill of teachers. More than 90% of students were overall satisfied with the teaching-learning and evaluation process. More than 90% of students were satisfied with the internal evaluation process. More than 95% students thought that the institution provides various aspects of growth even beyond the teaching learning process, by mentoring and inculcating employability as well as co and extracurricular aspects. The detailed analysis and suggestions were placed in the IQAC meeting dated 15th March 2022, for appraisal and suggestions of members and for further Action.

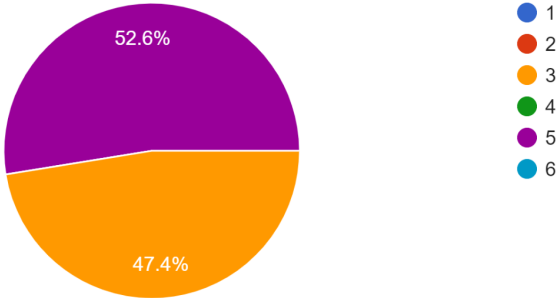

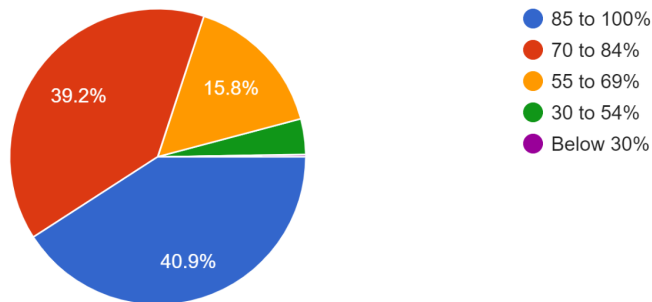

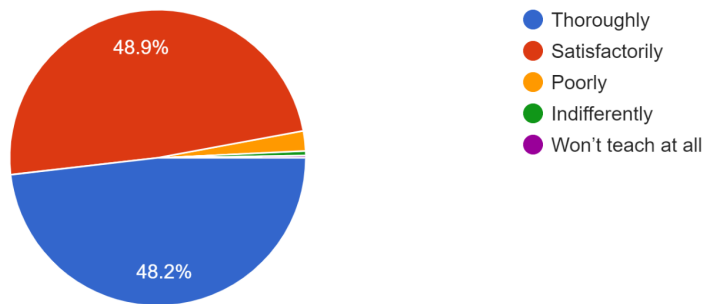
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

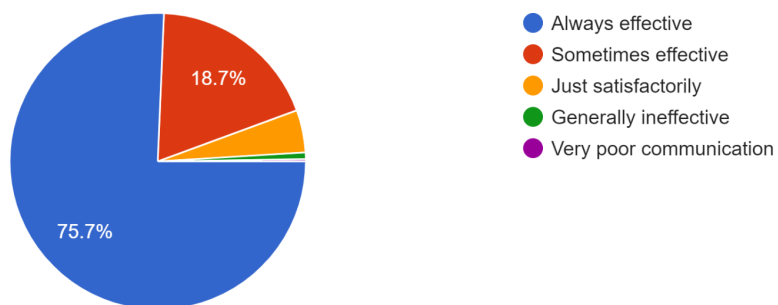
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

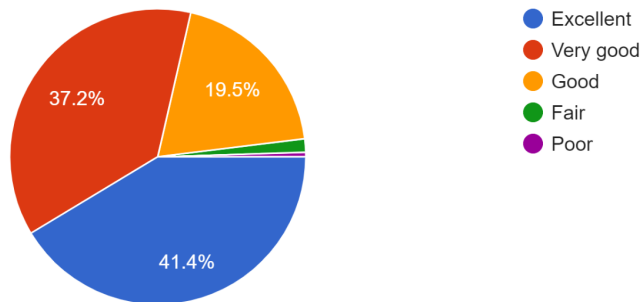
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

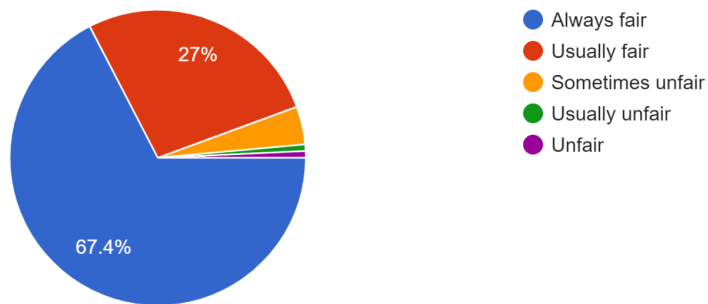
4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

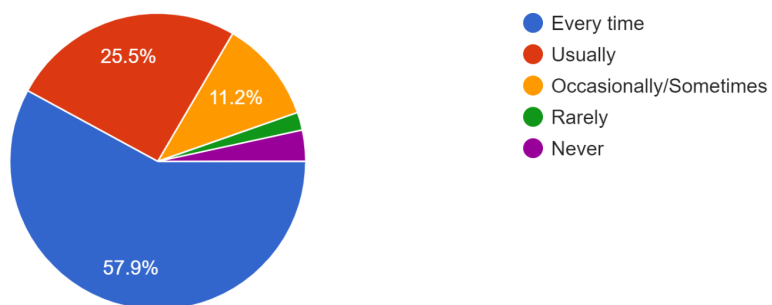
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

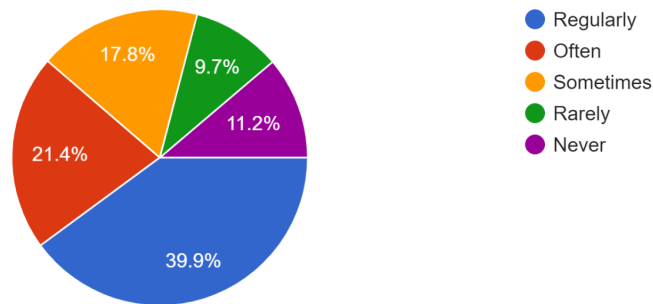
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

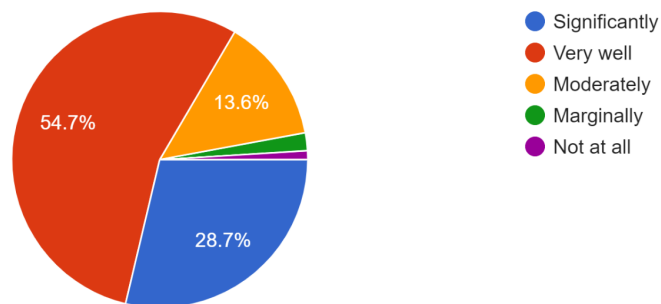
7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

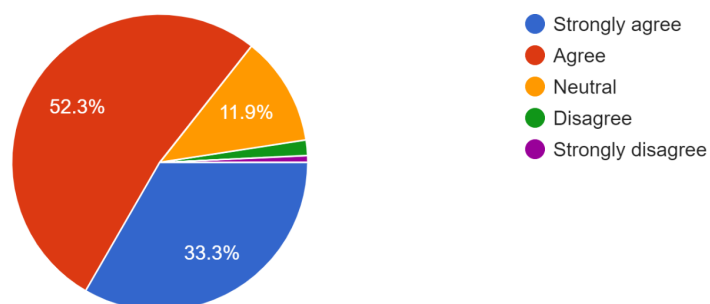
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

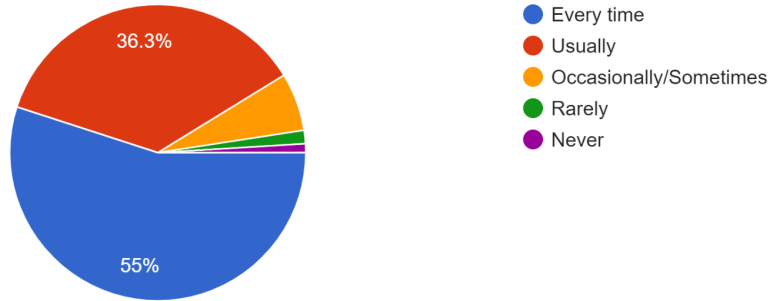
9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

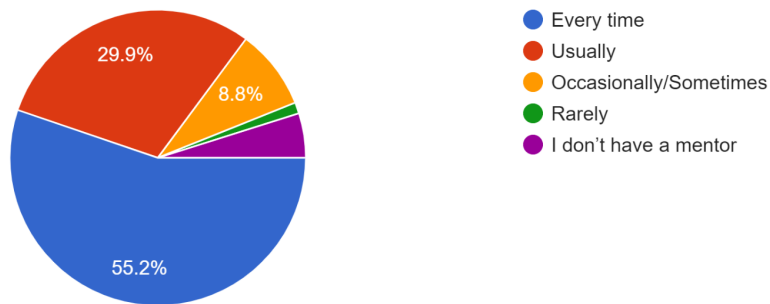
10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

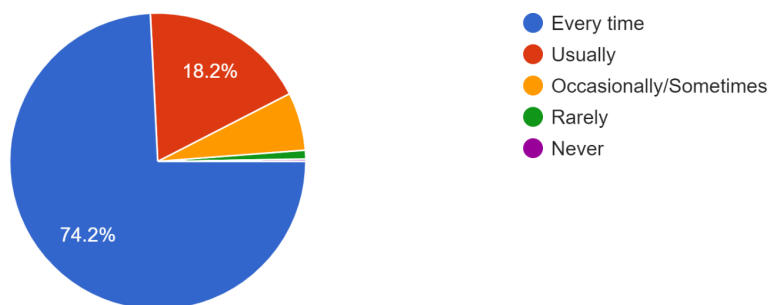
11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

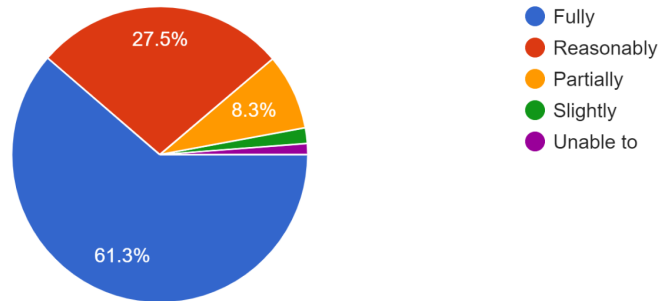
12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

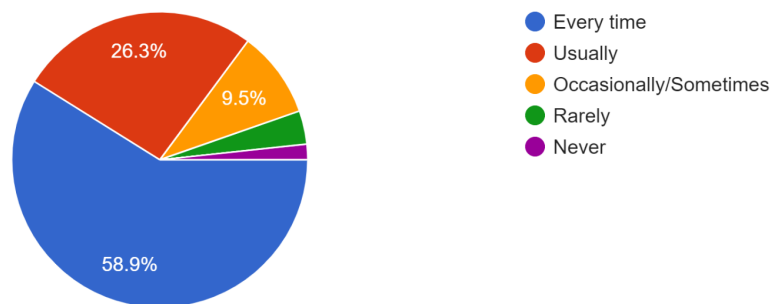
13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

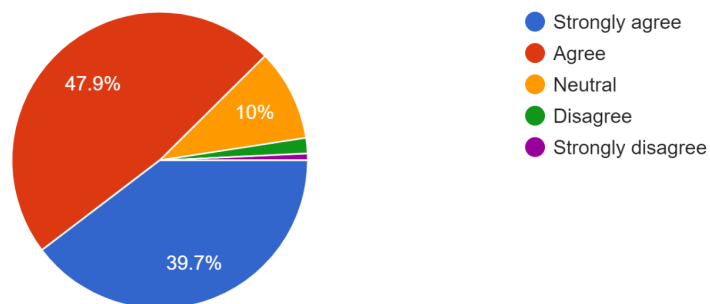
14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

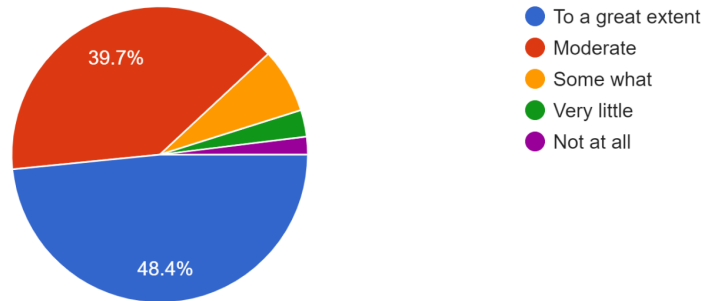
15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

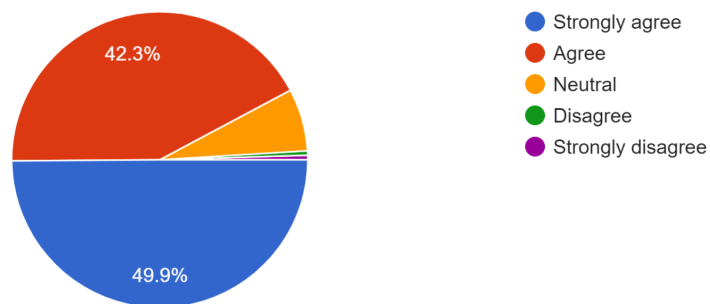
16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

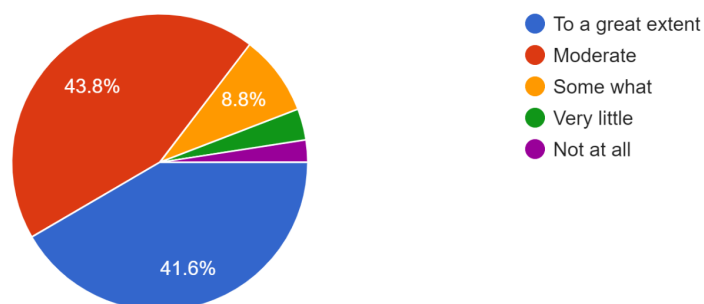
17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

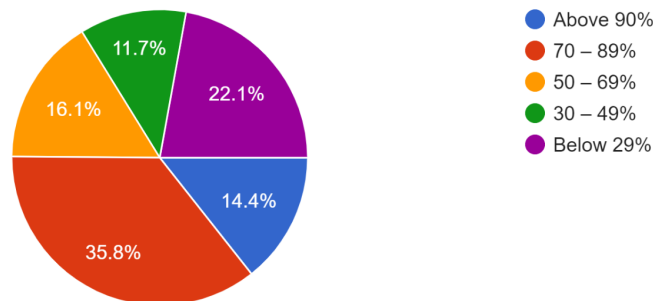
18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

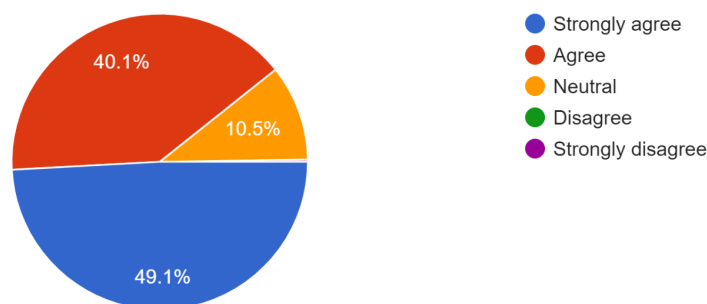
19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

a)

- The mentor-mentee conversation needs to be emphasised.
- Students have their freedom of choosing subjects in CBCS.

b)

- Infrastructural facilities should be improved focusing on class rooms, laboratories and library.

- More ICT tools such as LCD projectors should be there. Using audio visual mode of teaching.
- Better laboratory facilities. Labs should be cleaned regularly. Properly working equipment needed.
- Required improved canteen facility.
- The institute must provide a greater exposure to promote internship, student exchange, and field visit opportunities for students.
- Field trips would help us to overcome the daily monotony of classroom scenarios.
- College playground required proper maintenance round the year.
